Last Sunday, February 9

The Bible calls God's people not only to reject the institution of slavery but to make restitution to those who have been harmed by slavery, until the former slave and former free person are truly equals in the family of God. This week, we will consider what that call means for us who are the inheritors of the terrible racialized slavery of the 16th through 19th centuries, using Deuteronomy 15:12-15 and the book of Philemon as our guides.

We will finish our "Slavery and Freedom in the Bible" series by considering the "underground" slavery that exists in the modern world and how it is tied to our economic system. Isaiah 61:1-4 and 1 Corinthians 10:23-31 will be the primary texts to give us both guidance and hope in our world of slavery for how we can continue to pursue Biblical freedom.

Flowers and Trees

After completing the 2020 budget, it came to the attention of the AC that additional grounds

expenses are going to be necessary. There are three large Oak trees that need pruning. We also became aware that Becky Wigginton is invested in carrying out weed control in the flower beds and that some 2019 funds were spent on materials for this purpose. AC would like to propose that the funds set aside for flower beds in the 2020 budget (\$2,680) be redirected to tree pruning. Please give feedback on the budget redirection to Sam, Tim, or Laura.

AC is also considering the removal of the large tree between the building and the playground under the recommendation of one of the tree companies that gave an estimate. We could trim it now for \$1,445.00 but we may need to remove it soon for an additional cost of \$5,399.00. To share your views on this decision, reach out to Becky, Mike or Laura.
