Last Sunday, March 24

Last Sunday Frank guided us through Luke 12:13-34. In showing compassion to others, Jesus still wants us each to have enough for our daily sustenance; and yet, when we become preoccupied with our tomorrows, we exemplify scarcity rather than God's abundance.

This Sunday, March 31

In the sermon this Sunday, Sabrina will continue the theme of Jubilee found in Luke 14:1-24, primarily looking at verses 7-12. During Sabbath dinner at the home of one of the Pharisaic leaders, Jesus uses parables to teach deeper truths about table manners! Jesus' proclamation that the time of Jubilee has come (Lk 4:16-21) sets his followers free, both then and now, from entrenched social roles and hierarchies. This good news empowers us to live with joyful humility and hospitable hearts, understanding that each and every one of us has a "place of honor" in the Reign of God.

Not Just for Delegates & Pastors...

"Forsake not the practice of gathering yourselves together" (Hebrews 10:25). And we read in Acts chapter 2 how the early followers of Jesus frequently gathered for fellowship and worship: ⁴⁶ Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

In these days of digital electronic communication and our individualized, busy, self-sufficient lives, face to face, eye to eye, heart to heart presence with one another is a vanishing art form. As modern day Christians we are encouraged to gather weekly for worship and to join a small group where we can experience more intimate and personal sharing and fellowship.

In addition to these times of gathering within the congregational setting, occasionally we are asked to gather together with other congregations and the larger church. Acts 15 records such a gathering of the early followers of Jesus. Believers from Antioch got together with the mother group in Jerusalem, to listen for the voice of God in listening to each other. We have opportunity to do the same this summer in two such meetings:

First is Indiana-Michigan Mennonite
Conference Annual Meeting, Friday through
Saturday, June 13-15. This gathering, which
was held in Indianapolis last year, will be held
this year at Camp Amigo near Sturgis,
Michigan. The Annual Meeting Planners write:
This will be a time away to engage in our
spiritual practices around Romans 12 and 1
Peter 3:15 and be encouraged
through nature, workshops, and seminars from
our denominational agencies and conference
organizations.

There are more new things for Annual Sessions as we continue living into *Renewing a Vision*:

- Glen Guyton, Executive Director for Mennonite Church USA, preaching Thursday evening and sharing with delegates Friday morning
- A discounted registration cost for this year.
 Paid for out of some additional funds, the hope is to make this affordable for as many as possible.
- Children are free, up through high school, when they come along with parents. Yes, there will be activities!
- The spouse of a delegate is 50% off.
- A special celebration meal on Friday evening, with table cloths and servers
- 12 equipping <u>seminars</u> bringing new depth to our shared spiritual practices (descriptions attached)
- 3 seminars by Amigo Centre and many more opportunities to walk and rest in this setting
- Hear stories from our Michigan congregations

We pray that each of you will come to bend more toward Christ and to share the hope that is within you. (1 Peter 3:15)

Upon <u>registration</u>, attendees can choose three seminars/ workshops to attend during their time at Annual Sessions. The purpose of our Indiana Michigan Mennonite Conference seminars is to resource and equip leaders and participants in IMMC for witness, formation, discernment, and leadership in their congregations, communities, the region, and the world God loves.

Secondly, MCUSA's (Mennonite Church USA) Biennial Meeting July 2 – 6 (Tuesday – Saturday) at the Convention Center in Kansas City: Worship speakers for MennoCon19 come from a variety of vocations and locations across Mennonite Church USA. Worship will be inter-generational, bringing together youth, junior youth and adults. The

Scripture for convention is John 20:19-23 where Jesus appears to the frightened disciples after he has risen from the dead. Each worship service will focus on a small part of this Scripture, beginning with "God invites us" and moving through to the final service with "God Sends Us." The Grand Ballroom provides an intimate worship setting, and Seth Crissman will lead the worship band.
