Last Sunday, March 1

On the first Sunday of Lent, we traditionally read the story about Jesus being tempted in the wilderness according to Matthew or Luke. This year, however, we looked at Mark's short version of the story in Mark 1:9-20, which reminds us of how wild Jesus is, and how he comes to shatter our assumptions and challenge us to take new steps of faith. Let us brace ourselves as we invite this untamed lion of Judah into our lives!

This Sunday, March 8

Wilma Bailey will be preaching on the subject of sin. The text is Genesis 4:1-7.

Next Sunday, March 15

We will be looking at healing stories - from Mark 6:1-6 and 9:14-29 - in which Jesus confronts a significant obstacle to his ministry: unbelief. For Christians in a modern era, these stories are confusing if not troubling. Can a person really choose what to believe and what not to believe, or does the mind do that on its own? If we can choose what to believe, shouldn't we always choose to believe whatever positions have the most evidence behind them? How can Jesus command us to believe him? Let us pray that God will give us a deeper understanding of the contours of truth, doubt, and faith.

Lenten Resources

During the 6 weeks of Lent, there will be a new, weekly Lenten meditation guide attached in each Journeying Together. These Lenten meditations will guide us to pray using scriptures and will focus on how Jesus brings light into the shadow places of our lives and our world. The meditations will challenge us to seek and to finding hope in shine light, desperate times. There will be many prayer options suggested and you will likely not use each one listed. The meditation guides encourage us to be open to different ways of praying and where it
