Using Zoom safely and effectively
"Because we are holding most of our congregational meetings over Zoom during the COVID-19 outbreak, we face new challenges, including threats to our privacy and technological obstacles for those of us who lack internet access or expertise. To address these concerns, we are creating a new position for our congregational meetings called a "virtual usher." This person will host the meetings, operating mostly behind the scenes. He or she will be available to answer technical questions through the chat feature on zoom and will be monitoring attendance in order to protect the community from unwelcome intrusion.

For any sessions that involve a "prayer & sharing" element, we are requiring all participants to provide some identifying information so that the usher will know who is "in the room" when sharing occurs. For most of us, this will not require any effort: if we can see your face or if a name that we recognize is listed as your ID, then we will not need any additional information. However, if someone

logs in and does not provide identifying information, we will move them to a "waiting room" until we can verify that they are either a Shalom member or were invited to join by one. If you are having trouble accessing the conversation, you can contact the virtual usher directly. This week's virtual usher is Sam Bixler, whom you can reach at 317-701-3864."
