One of the joys of being a Mennonite is learning our special recipe for Alphabet Soup. It seems that every church denomination has its own recipe. The ingredients for ours include MCC, MC-USA, MDS, MVS, MMN, and more. For those of us who are newer to the Mennonite fold, it can be a challenge not only to know what the letters stand for but also what they actually mean! Perhaps in future mileposts we will examine each one of them. For now let's focus on MMN: Mennonite Mission Network.

Mennonite Mission Network is, as its name suggests, the mission agency of Mennonite Church-USA (a/k/a MC-USA!). Based in Elkhart, IN, MMN equips churches for ministries of service, reconciliation, and evangelism all over the world. Their resources include their own alphabet soup of opportunities: MDI (Missional Discipleship Initiative), MVS (Mennonite Volunteer Service), PJSN (Peace and Justice Support Network), DOOR, SOOP, and more. Many youth and adults from Shalom have participated and served in these programs.

A substantial amount of our Shalom budget goes to support MMN, including our missionaries Peter and Delicia Wigginton-Bravo in Ecuador. And just a couple of Sundays ago we sent all of our donations from Pizzas for Peace to the PJSN (see above!). This September, on Peace Sunday, Jason Boone, the Minister of Peace and Justice from PJSN will visit and share with us during worship and Sunday School.

Last weekend I had the delightful opportunity to meet over coffee with Karla Minter, the MMN Church Relations Representative, and learned so much more than I had ever known about all that MMN exists for. She is particularly excited about their church planting initiatives to spread the Mennonite message among what she believes are increasing numbers of people interested in our understanding of the gospel of Jesus Christ. She also expressed joy about the nurturing support we have given to the Mara church and our hospitality to the Iglesia Amigos.

Once we know the recipe, we can appreciate so much more the complexity of spices and seasonings and fresh ingredients--and, mostly, love--that goes into making our Alphabet Soup. Let's all take some time to learn and taste it!
