WORSHIP: Our relationship with God

<u>Last Sunday (12/13)</u> was the third Sunday of Advent, and we joined East Goshen Mennonite Church, with their church planning the service and Pastor Naomi Yoder preaching the sermon.

<u>This Sunday (12/20)</u> we will be studying the apocalyptic writings of the Older Testament, which involve disorienting images of supernatural creatures and global events. Although these passages may seem strange to us, they pave the way for a new concept to emerge in the Bible - that of powers and principalities - which shaped the hopes and expectations that the Jewish people had for their Messiah.

<u>Next Sunday (12/27)</u>, we will be celebrating Christmas by considering the ways in which Jesus fulfilled, challenged, and exceeded the expectations that Jewish people had for their Messiah, with the book of Hebrews serving as our guide.

Longest Night Service: (please note corrected day of the week is <u>Monday</u>):

The Christmas holidays can be difficult when our personal experience of life doesn't match the "holiday spirit" projected around us. Also, holidays are often times of experiencing the dark night as we grieve the loss of loved ones. 2020 has been a year of challenges and grief in many forms for varied reasons. A Longest Night service is one Christian tradition to companion those of us who seek hope and restoration in the healing love of God.

On Monday, December 21, at 7:00 pm, Shalom will have a Longest Night service on the eve of the winter solstice, the night we literally have the longest period of darkness during the year. This will be meditative with time for reflection. You will be invited to light one or more candles if desired to commemorate different categories of losses. As this will be virtual via Zoom, if you wish to light candles (or flashlights), please have these supplies nearby prior to the beginning of the service. The service will be recorded so it can be accessed at another time if the 7:00 time is not convenient for you. Please invite others who may be interested. From **The Center and Library for the Bible and Social Justice**: How do activism and scholarship contribute to our understanding of Scripture in the world today?

In this session, CPTer and lifelong peace activist, Weldon Nisly and biblical scholar Tom Boomershine will discuss their commitment to understand and respond to the Gospel's call to peacemaking — within the academy, within Christian community, and in conflict zones around the world. They will focus on the struggle of the Kurds in Northern Iraq targeted by Turkey's military in the context of the Iraq war, as well as the Palestinian struggle in the Israeli-occupied West Bank.

Several months ago our congregation approved supporting Indiana Assistance to Immigrants in Detention (IAID). Brian has been involved with the development of this ecumenical non-profit organization which seeks to provide support for persons detained in Indiana by the federal Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agency. The only detention facility used by ICE in Indiana is the Clay County Jail at Brazil, Indiana. We have not known of any persons being detained by ICE over the past few months, so there is little to report about IAID activities. A goal is to arrange visitation with any persons who are detained in order to: 1) provide support to those persons, and 2) check on how person's needs are being met while they are in detention. The Outreach Commission will keep you informed if there are further developments in the ministry of IAID, and how we might be involved. ~ Brad Yoder
