Adam Graber Roth, Donor Relations Associate of Mennonite Central Committee, Great Lakes will visit, offering reflections during worship and an adult Sunday School class. His sermon title will be "And who is my neighbor?" with the text from Luke 10:25-37.

Coming Fall of 2020: VOICES Together, the newest Mennonite hymnal! This will be included in next year's budget. There is a financial incentive in making a decision early. If we purchase 120 pew editions (they come in cases of 12; we need 100 books for our pews), it would cost \$2878.80. There is a 7% discount for quantity, then, if paid in full by May 1, 2020, there is another 10% discount = \$2409.73, a savings of almost \$470. We would also plan to purchase a large-print edition (\$43.99), and the accompaniment book \$89.99). Also, for every case of the pew edition we purchase we can buy a Worship Leader edition for \$9.99 (instead of \$19.99). We feel this could be a useful resource and would like to purchase 3. The grand total for all of this is \$2573.68 (plus shipping).

We want to point out that a Projection edition is available for projecting lyrics and/or music for \$499.99. Looking at the music projection, there are a lot of slides for each song since 4-part hymns can only project 2 staffs worth of music on each slide, while unison songs fit 3 staffs on a slide. Our recommendation at this time is to pass on purchasing the projection edition. We

have our own way of projecting the lyrics and we will have the books available for new songs. Direct any questions or comments to one of the Worship Commission members. More information can be found at http://voicestogetherhymnal.org/
